14	E. revolutum	Delicate deep pink flowers. This species from Western North America has grace and charm. It has striking flowers and beautifully mottled leaves. In our experience this species is a little less vigorous than E. 'Knightshayes Pink' and E. 'Harvington Wild Salmon'.		4.95
